Small Group Discussion Questions

Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion.

Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through "observation" leaving enough time for "reflection", "discussion", and "surrender."

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: What do the scripture passages say? Read 1 John 3:11-24

- 1. What is 'the message that has been heard since the beginning?'
- 2. What did Cain do?
- 3. What is the transformation referenced in verse 14?
- 4. If we see someone in need, what are we told to do?

Reflection and Discussion: What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures? How do the scriptures connect to everyday life?

- 5. Who is John quoting/referencing in verse 15?
- 6. Does verse 15 literally mean what it says? If so, what do we do about this?
- 7. What did Jesus surrender for you?
- 8. What do you surrender for others?

Surrender: Responding to God's voice.

- 9. How can we, as a group, show love in deed and truth to those outside of our group?
- 10. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
