Small Group Discussion Questions

Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion.
Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What does the scripture say? Read 1st John 4:10-12*

1. From where does love originate? Why does that matter?
2. What does it mean that Jesus is the “atoning sacrifice for our sins?”
3. Why does John say “No one has ever seen God” after telling us to love others?

Read 1st John 5:1-4

4. What are the implications of the statement that believers in Jesus are “born of God?”
5. Why does John say God’s commands are “not a burden?”
6. What role does faith play in what John says in these two passages?

Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts? How do the scriptures connect to everyday life?*

7. What does being a “born again” Christian mean to you?
8. Where does faith in God matter for your daily life right now?
9. How are you helping people see God?
10. Where would you like to more “conquer the world?”

What can you do to have more faith?

11. Application: *What is God saying to you?*

12. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
