

October 5th, 2025 Small Group Discussion Questions

Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion.

Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through "observation" leaving enough time for "reflection", "discussion", and "surrender."

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: What does the scripture say? Read 1st John 1:1-4.

- 1. How many different thoughts does John include in his long first sentence?
- 2. What does John want us to know about his credibility?
- 3. What reasons does John give for why he is writing this letter?

Reflection and Discussion: What are some first thoughts? How do the scriptures connect to everyday life?

- 4. Why did John begin his letter with such a long first sentence? What does that say about his mind and emotions? How should that influence our attitude as we read what God inspired him to share?
- 5. How confident is John in what he believes about Jesus? Why?
- 6. What does John say is the foundation of Christian fellowship?
- 7. Can we be as confident as John in what we believe about Jesus?

Application: What is God saying to you?

- 8. How can you "experience" God this week in a way that will build your faith?
- 9. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
