Getting Started

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What does this scripture passage say? Read Hebrew 10:19-25*

1. What is the Old Testament imagery described in this passage and where in the OT is that imagery talked about?
 2. How does this imagery point to Jesus and how does Jesus fulfill what that imagery points to?
 3. What is our responsibility in this passage as a response to what God through Christ has done?

Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?*

How do the scriptures connect to everyday life.

4. What does it mean to be a “member of the body of Christ” and how does that connect with what it means for us to be saved?
 5. What relationship does the challenge for us to “hold on to the confession of our hope without wavering” (Vs 23) have to do with how we should “not neglect to gather together” (vs25)?
 6. We’re challenging our church attenders to make regular church engagement a priority in their life. How have you experienced the struggle of keeping that a priority in your life? What helped you to stay connected?
 7. Published research states that over the past 25 years 40 million Americans who were at least once a month attenders stopped attending church. The research also showed that a significant number of those would consider returning to church if someone invited them. What are ways that you as an individual, or small group could pray for and invite people to connect with you at ChangePoint?
