Getting Started

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What do the scripture passages say? Read Matthew 24:45-51 & 25:14-30*

1. What are the similarities between these two parables?
 2. Since both of these are parables Jesus shared while teaching about the end times, what key message is He emphasizing for His listeners to pay attention to?
 3. What are the adjectives used to describe the characters in each parable and what does it signify about them?

Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?*

How do the scriptures connect to everyday life.

4. How do you stay faithful in obedience to what you know God has commanded for you to do over a lifetime?
 5. How do the motives behind our actions either make our actions honoring to God or dishonoring to God?
 6. What council would you give to someone who for a long time seemed to be in the faith, but over time was starting to drift into indifference or defiance of the faith?
 7. We face ongoing temptations for temporary sinful pleasure now over eternal joy. How can and should thinking about the second coming keep us centered on eternal joy over sin?
