Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion.

Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through "observation" leaving enough time for "reflection", "discussion", and "surrender."

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: What do the scripture passages say? Read Acts 4:32-37 & 2 Timothy 3

- 1. What do the things that the early church is doing tell you about who they are?
- 2. In the list Paul writes to Timothy, which descriptor do you most see in our culture today?
- What are the similarities between the two passages?

Reflection and Discussion: What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures? How do the scriptures connect to everyday life?

- What does it mean to be a "member of the body of Christ" and how does that connect with the free gift of salvation?
- 5. In the list Paul writes to Timothy, which descriptor do you most struggle with and why?
- What is a gift/blessing you've experienced due to your willingness to stick it out and plug in? 6.
- How was the Word of God transformed your life? Share your 'life verse.'

Surrender: Responding to God's voice.

- How can we, as a group, make it easier for other people to join our 'tribe?'
- 9. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
