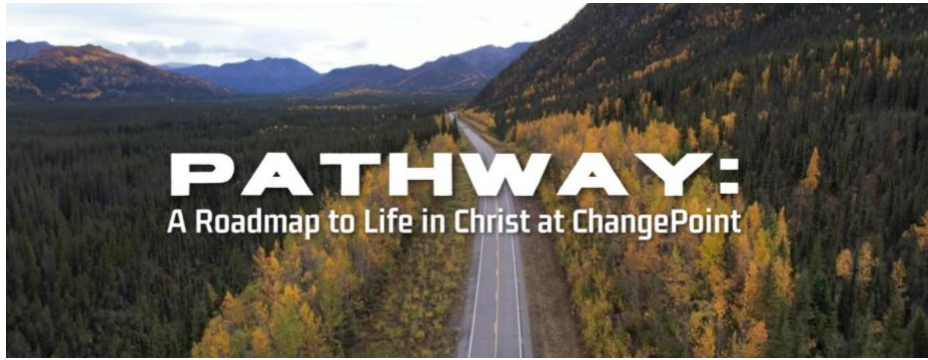

Getting Started

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What do the scripture passages say? Read Acts 4:32-37 & 2 Timothy 3*

1. What do the things that the early church is doing tell you about who they are?
 2. In the list Paul writes to Timothy, which descriptor do you most see in our culture today?
 3. What are the similarities between the two passages?

Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?*

How do the scriptures connect to everyday life?

4. What does it mean to be a “member of the body of Christ” and how does that connect with the *free gift* of salvation?
 5. In the list Paul writes to Timothy, which descriptor do you most struggle with and why?
 6. What is a gift/blessing you’ve experienced due to your willingness to stick it out and plug in?
 7. How was the Word of God transformed your life? Share your ‘life verse.’
