Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion.

Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through "observation" leaving enough time for "reflection", "discussion", and "surrender."

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: What do the scripture passages say? Read Acts 2:41-42; Matthew 12:46-50, 6:9-13; and Act 17:1

- 1. What does the first description of the Christian church in Acts 2:42 tell us about what those first Christians did?
- 2. What does Jesus call his disciples in Matt. 12:46-50?
- 3. Is Jesus' example prayer in Matt. 6:9-13 an individual or collective prayer?
- 4. How often did the Berean Christians study the Bible?

Reflection and Discussion: What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures? How do the scriptures connect to everyday life.

- 5. Why did Jesus call his disciples his "mother and brothers"?
- 6. How important is it that we experience "spiritual family" with people in our church? What prevents us from experiencing it? What steps can we take to experience "spiritual family?"
- 7. How important is it to be a life-long student of God's word? What does that mean? Are regularly attending Sunday services sufficient?

Surrender: Responding to God's voice.

- 8. On a scale from 1-10, how much "spiritual family" are you experiencing with people at your church? How much are you learning from God's word each month?
- 9. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
