- 3. Read Genesis 12:10 13:1; Joshua 9:1 15. What keeps people from seeking God about the issues that they confront in life? What are some common issues in life that people often fail to seek the Lord about?
- 4. Read 2 Peter 1: 3, 4. What are some promises of God that Christians can hold onto? Are there personal promises of God that are significant to you?
- 5. Read Matthew 5:29, 30. Recall the story of the shampoo commercial. What is the problem with just a "little bit of sin"?
- 6. Read Proverbs 3:5, 6. What does it mean to "lean on your own understanding"? In what areas of life do people do this in particular? What is the alternative plan? Explain.
- 7. Look through the full story how do you see the Exodus...or the gospel represented in this passage?

### Living

- 8. How do you *personally* seek counsel from the Lord?
- 9. Read Romans 10:17. What tips would you give someone who wanted to strengthen their faith in God's promises?
- 10. Read John 10:28, 29. How do you answer the person who believes that they have snatched themselves out of Jesus hand? Can you point to other verses to allay their fears?
