Theme: "Manny"

Scripture: Proverbs 16:9 (HCSB) "A man's heart plans his way, but the Lord determines his steps."

A Thought: It was special day at the coffee cafe. I had the pleasure of meeting two young men who were enrolled in an on-line bible college. Both were studying for a test. After a brief introduction our chitchat turned to how our Lord has blessed our lives. At the opposite end of the table a tall and heavy-set gent was listening quite intently to our conversation. His sun-burn face with with a heavy five o'clock shadow conveyed a weariness. His clothes were soiled with sweat stains and grime. This man worked hard for a living. Thin lines furrowed above the ridge of his eyes. A mortal, laden with yesterday's burdens. "A joyful heart makes a face cheerful, but a sad heart produces a broken spirit." (Proverbs 15:13) I was on the verge of an introduction when Manny interrupted and joined in the conversation. A Mike Tyson soft voice quietly with a sense of indignation sputtered.. "God, God, He, He doesn't do anything, especially for people like me." He continued, "He just sits in heaven, looks down on us. I guess sometimes He does but for only for special people." Manny starred at all three of us and waited for an answer. Whoa! Many minutes ensued with rapid-fire testimonies, appropriate scriptures and resolving with the determination that our Lord Jesus Christ loved each of us. One of the young men stated that a good father withholds no good thing from his son and would give him a fish instead of a stone. Manny responded not unlike many of us when our spirit is at low ebb...."but I feel God always gives me stones (trials)." The other student responded stating that the scriptures are clear according to (Matthew 7:7-11 ESV), (9) "What a man among you, if his son asks him for bread, will give him a stone?"
