Pastor and Rebecca still plan to be there until she is hopefully released on November 2, and then they will return to the Tri-Cities within a day or two after that. Pastor Randy Hunter will be leading worship on Sunday, November 2. Pastor Tim will then be back to his regular duties, but will plan to be more present at home, especially during the day, for the entire month of November. Rebecca's surgeon expects that she will be able to resume most of her basic lifestyle within 4-6 weeks. Many of you have graciously offered your support. Pastor Tim shares, "The best way you can support us is with your prayers, patience, and taking care of each other. We need you to be present and active as the church to support each other as I will be more focused on my wife. If you would like to support in other ways, Brigetta has set up a meal train.
