


About Life Groups *An Invitation For You*



Full Group Meets: 1st & 3rd Wednesday | 6:30-8:30PM | Church

Group Leader | Teresa Fajt




Meets: One Friday per month | 7:00PM | Rotate Homes




This group is comprised of middle aged and retiree couples. This group is currently full and not available to take on additional participants.




This group is comprised of all demographics, meeting weekly on Monday evenings, beginning in February, to watch and discuss The Chosen series.
