- Demonstrated experience as a worship leader in a church or ministry setting
- Strong background in worship music with the ability to combine and lead both traditional and contemporary expressions of worship
- Ability to develop and lead worship in a new Sanctuary environment
- Experience leading and contributing in a fast-paced ministry setting
- Familiarity with modern technology to enhance worship experiences
- Excellent organizational and time-management skills
- Bachelor's degree in a related field or equivalent ministry experience

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

Worship Leadership

- Plan and lead weekly worship services, special events, and community gatherings in partnership with the Lead Pastor and the Worship Planning Team
- Ensure the recommended songs and elements engage people across generations in authentic biblical worship

Ongoing Duties

- Oversee worship staff, volunteers, and worship ministry budget
- Recruit, train, and mentor leaders within worship and technology ministries
- Recruit, train, direct, rehearse, and schedule music and arts groups (choir, orchestra, band, etc.)
- Manage scheduling for services, rehearsals, facility use, and ministry communications
- Collaborate with other ministry areas to create cross-ministry worship experiences for the congregation and community
- Participate in appropriate professional and ministry networks for continued growth
