JANUARY 2026 PRAYER POINTS

PREPARING YOURSELF TO PRAY (4 Minutes)

Lord Jesus, we are trusting in the blood of Jesus to cleanse our sins.

“But if we walk in the light as He Himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.” 1 John 1:7

- Thank you, Jesus, for sacrificing Your blood and Your life on the cross.
- Jesus, wash away all my sins and guilt and cleanse me with Your precious blood.

Lord, thank you for renewing my fellowship with God. I love you, Lord Jesus, with all my heart, and with all my soul, and with all my might.

PREPARING TO PRAY IN THE POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT (4 Minutes)

Father, prepare me to pray in the power of the Holy Spirit.

“Praying in the Holy Spirit.” Jude 20

- Lord, I fully surrender to the Lordship of Jesus Christ.
- Oh God, fill me and control me now with the Holy Spirit.
- Jesus, lead me to pray in and by the Holy Spirit's power.

Father, in Jesus' name and through His precious blood, I ask You to empower me now by faith to pray in and by the Holy Spirit's power for each of these prayer points.

PRAYER POINTS FOR JANUARY (20 Minutes)

(1) Lord Jesus, TOGETHER we pray in agreement to commit this church-wide prayer ministry to You, because when we pray, God moves! Your Word says:

“And when they had prayed, the place in which they were gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and continued to speak the word of God with boldness.”

Acts 4:31 ESV

- Oh God, give our church the burden to pray individually, pray together, and pray for one another.
- Lord, shake Your church and Your people here with a mighty move of God as we've never experienced before. Give us spiritual revival and awakening!
- Father, fill our people and our church with the power of the Holy Spirit of God.

Holy Spirit, speak God's Word, the Gospel of Jesus Christ, through our people with clarity and boldness.

(2) Father, lead our church through our 21 Days of Prayer from January 4-25, and increase our burden, commitment, and passion to engage in extraordinary prayer—prayer beyond the ordinary.

We stand upon this command:

"Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results." James 5:16 NLT

- Lord, make us more passionate to pray in and for our church worship services, in small-group ministries, among all adults, in men's and women's ministries, in college students' ministry, in student ministry, and with our children.
- Holy Spirit, restore broken and strained relationships, marriages, and friendships; and Lord, help us to be willing to humble ourselves and confess our sins to God and one another.
- Lord, lead us to "pray for one another" everywhere we go, fill our worship services with prayer for one another, and pray for healing in every way.

Oh God, in these 21 Days of Prayer, transform our lives and church through the supernatural power of prayer.

(3) Holy Spirit, empower our church in 2026 to reach Fort Smith and the River Valley for Jesus Christ, giving us the strategy, power, and intentionality to accomplish it. We pray:

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." Acts 1:8

- Jesus, we need You in every way to help us reach the lost in Fort Smith and the River Valley who do not know You personally.
- Jesus, give us the heart, strategy, and intentionality to reach lost children, lost teenagers, lost college students, and lost adults of all ages for Jesus Christ.
- Oh God, mobilize every member of our church to begin sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ with lost people and to win them to faith in Jesus Christ.
- Father, we ask You that we begin to see people of all ages give their lives to Christ and follow You in public baptism every Sunday.

Jesus, in the year 2026, we ask You to draw lost people to You as Lord and Savior like never before through our Grand Avenue Baptist Family.

(4) Lord, help each Christ-follower in our church to honor You by giving at least ten percent of all You give them in 2026 and to fulfill this dynamic promise in their life:

"Bring the full tenth into the storehouse so that there may be food in My house. Test Me in this way," says the Lord of Armies. "See if I will not open the floodgates of heaven and pour out a blessing for you without measure." Malachi 3:10

- God, we stand on Malachi 3:10, knowing that we should faithfully give at least the first ten percent of all You give us through Your church.
- Father, we bless You and agree with Your Word: “The purpose of tithing is to teach you always to put God first in your lives.” Deuteronomy 14:23 TLB
- Lord, all we have in life comes from You. God, we recognize that You own everything, and we own absolutely nothing. So, may we walk in obedience to Your Word, practicing biblical stewardship.
- Father, we ask You to set free our church from anything financially, materially, or physically that restrains us from being all You desire us to be.

God, in Jesus’ name, we ask You to fulfill Your promise to open wide the heavens and pour out blessings until we have no more needs. We trust You!

(5) God, we ask You to fill, empower, and anoint Dr. Ronnie Floyd, our Interim Pastor, with the Holy Spirit as he leads our church, proclaims God’s Word, and provides us with spiritual leadership and guidance. We stand upon this promise:

“My speech and my proclamation were not with persuasive words of wisdom, but with a powerful demonstration by the Spirit, so that your faith might not be based on men’s wisdom but on God’s power.” 1 Corinthians 2:4-5

- Lord, give Pastor Floyd Your wisdom, direction, insight, and anointing as he serves with us during this transition season.
- God, as Pastor Floyd leads us to see our church revitalized and positioned for the future God has for us, give him everything he needs, and may we surround him in prayer.
- Lord Jesus, as Pastor Floyd works with our Ministry Staff Team, we pray for each of them to be filled with the Spirit and empowered to lead our church to grow. We pray for:

Oh God, **TOGETHER** we pray that our church will come together in biblical unity around our mission to reach our city, region, country, and the world for Jesus Christ.

- Go through these five requests one by one in the final two minutes, calling out to God at each major point, appealing for His supernatural intervention, and thanking Him in advance for answering our prayer **TOGETHER**.
