# **ELEMENTARY FEES - 2025/2026**

### **APPLICATION PROCESS & FEE**

Families who are new to Immanuel will follow an application process. This process will consist of completing an application, providing Immanuel with most recent report cards, and participating in a screening with the grade level teacher. There is a one-time, nonrefundable application fee of \$75 payable at the time of the application submittal.

#### REGISTRATION

Once the application process is complete and a student has been admitted, a Continuous Enrollment From must be completed. Current ILCS families will begin with the Continuous Enrollment Form and pay a \$40 assessment fee if a screening with the grade level teacher is required. The registration fee for the 2025-2026 school year is \$300 per student for new and returning families and is due at the time of the submittal of the Continuous Enrollment Form. Should you, for any reason, decide to withdraw your child before June 1, \$100 of the fee may be refunded to you upon written request. After June 1, the entire registration fee is non-refundable. The registration fee covers the cost of textbooks, yearbook, earthquake preparedness, and our school-wide achievement testing.

# **TUITION (Annual)**

Elementary students' tuition will process August – June with no payment in January (January is when the registration fee for the following school year is automatically charges to the FACTS account), dependent upon the payment plan selected in FACTS Management. There is a 5% discount when paying tuition in full before September 15. Tuition that is paid in full is non-refundable. There is also a 5% discount on each subsequent tuition when registering more than one child.

Immanuel Lutheran School has contracted with FACTS Management Company to help manage our tuition collection. For new families, once you have registered, you will receive an email from Facts Management with steps to complete your account set up and choose your payment plan. #### SCHOOL ENHANCEMENT - SCRIP

SCRIP profit obligation per school year is \$300 per two parent family and \$200 for a single parent family. Credit is earned by purchasing SCRIP gift cards sold at Immanuel or online. The percentage attached to each specific gift card becomes the amount credited towards fulfillment of the annual obligation. If a family chooses not to participate, the total obligation will be billed to FACTS at the end of each school year. The SCRIP profit covers the cost for educational enhancement for the children. SCRIP monies are used to upgrade technology, curriculum and instruction. SCRIP accounts must be set up online by each family in order to receive credit for purchases. ## STUDENT SUPPLIES

Individual supplies (such as paper, notebooks, markers, etc.) are purchased by each student. A list with specific items for each classroom will be available each summer. Students are asked to bring these supplies with them to Roadrunner Roundup or on the first day of school. Planners (assignment books) will be provided by the school for students in Grades 3 - 6. English Standard Version (ESV) Bibles are needed by each child in grades 2 - 6 and are purchased through the school.

## **BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL CARE**

"Kids Kare" is offered as a service to our families. Our program begins at 7 a.m. for before school care and ends at 6 p.m. for after school care. The hourly rate for 2025/2026 is \$6 per hour. Special days will have special rates may require a separate registration form.

### **OTHER COSTS**

During the school year, parents may be asked to donate items or funds for classroom parties or other events. Chapel shirts (required every Wednesday for Chapel) and school spirit wear are offered for sale during the year through 1<sup>st</sup> Place Spiritwear. After hour curricular programs are available on an individual basis. Fees are determined by the instructor. There is a cost for recorders for our 1st graders, and for Outdoor Education for 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders. Field trips vary throughout the year. Parents will be notified in advance of any field trip and the amount of money needed to cover the cost.
