Sermon Series: Love & Marriage: Love

Opening question: What is love?

Sermon Synopsis: We can't talk about marriage without talking about love, but what is love? Think about it, where did we get our understanding about love? Is love a feeling or an action or both? In this sermon we will dive into what it means to love another person the way God loves us.

Bible Reading

Reading the Bible is about reading for practice and spiritual formation – spiritual formation, in which the reader seeks to be formed by the Spirit of God.

Passage(s) from the sermon: I Corinthians 13:4-8(CEB)

What word stuck to you?

Reread the passage and talk about how each of these attributes of love are actions not feelings.

Discipleship Point: Love is not a feeling but an action.

Application: Discuss with your small group your love language? (**5 Love Languages:** words of affirmation, quality time, physical touch, acts of service, receiving gifts)

Personal Prayer Request

Share a one or two sentence prayer request with the Small Group for this next week. Remember these prayer requests are about **your life**, not someone else's.

(Sample Prayer)
