Responsibilities/Duties

- Oversee the proper operation of audio, lighting, media, and video broadcast equipment at all campuses.
- Create and model a culture that strives for excellence and regular improvement.
- Creates a comprehensive checklist to ensure consistency with live worship experiences.
- Seek out and implement new technology and resources that improve Sunday morning experiences.
- Troubleshoot and fix any issues that may arise during worship experiences or during the week.
- Creates or contracts set design- Oversee implementation in collaboration with the Creative Director
- Gives coaching and leadership to Production directors and/or worship leaders at other locations, as needed.
- Contributes to the planning process as needed
- Schedules system maintenance as required throughout the year.
- Prepare and manage ProPresenter and media computers.
- Oversee, recruit, schedule, and provide training for FOH, ProPresenter, lighting, broadcasting, camera operators & all other volunteer positions.
- Develop and train production team volunteers to assist in running production needs for various services [weekends, events, etc].

- Lead and direct production staff, and volunteers: develop, build, and create systems and maintain equipment across our North Oak campus.
 - Communicate and work with campus worship leaders to execute weekend services with excellence.
 - Oversee Programming and scheduling of ProPresenter files for the North Oak Campus.
 - Directs production of broadcasting on Sundays and special events at the North Oak Campus.
