Small Group Questions

(Built from your sermon flow: Narrow Gate \rightarrow False Prophets \rightarrow Hear & Do \rightarrow Begin With the End in Mind.)

1. Icebreaker

• Share about a time you started a project or job without fully understanding the goal. What happened when the "end" finally came into view?

2. Read the Passage

Read Matthew 7:13-29 together.

3. Understanding the Text

A. Enter Through the Narrow Gate (7:13-14)

- 1. Jesus says the narrow way is "hard" and few find it.
 - What makes the narrow path difficult in real life?
- 2. What are some "wide path" beliefs or ideas our culture considers normal?

B. Beware of False Prophets (7:15-23)

- 3. Jesus says we will recognize false teachers "by their fruits."
 - O What's the difference between actions and fruit/results?
- 4. Why is it sometimes necessary to "wait" to see what kind of fruit someone produces?
- 5. How can good actions sometimes hide bad fruit—and vice versa?

C. Hear and Do Jesus' Words (7:24-27)

- 6. Both builders heard Jesus, but only one acted.
 - O In what ways do Christians today "hear" but fail to "do"?

4. Heart-Level Reflection

- 7. Which of Jesus' warnings—about the path, the teachers, or the foundation—hits closest to home for you, and why?
- 8. What storms (past or present) have revealed what your life is actually built upon?

5. Application - Lead & Lag Measures

- 9. What "lead measures" (habits, disciplines, choices) help keep you on the narrow path?
- 10. What "fruit" or "lag measures" are you seeing in your spiritual life right now—either encouraging or concerning?
- 11. What steps can you take this week to build more intentionally on Christ's words?

6. Prayer

- Pray that God would give your group discernment about the path you walk, the teachers you follow, and the foundation you build on.
- Pray for the courage to do Jesus' words, not merely hear them.
