# Mama Raised you Right

I have often been asked, “Phillip, why are you such a big Oklahoma Sooners fan? Did you go to school there?” No, is the answer to the second question. So let me try to give you an answer to the first question. I was raised in Oklahoma. Some of my earliest memories are from Saturday afternoons in the fall when mom and I would watch the Sooners play football on television. One of my favorite memories is the day that Oklahoma beat Ohio State on a last second field goal. I got so excited that I jumped up and knocked over my mom’s favorite potted plant in the living room. There was shattered porcelain and dirt all over our living room carpet. Mom just looked at the mess and said, “You are lucky he made that field goal.” Mom also bought me OU football jerseys and shirts that were always the first things worn after laundry day. In elementary school about once a month we would have movie days. The entire school would come to the gym for an afternoon of movies. Often they would show us highlight films from the previous Sooners football season. I went to college in Nebraska and Texas. But by that time my loyalty to OU was so deep that I remained a fan even while living in enemy territory. Now I am living back in Texas surrounded by Longhorn and Bear fans, but I still stand proudly for my Sooners. In the environment that I was raised in I thought that everyone was a fan of the Oklahoma Sooners. By the time I was old enough to know differently my commitments were so deep that no one was going to change me.

Being a fan of the Sooners was not the greatest gift that mom gave me. Growing up I cannot remember a Sunday morning that mom did not take my brother, sister and I to church. Much like the post office, through rain, snow, sleet and hail we were always there. There were some Wednesday nights when I would have to leave my little league baseball game in the middle of an inning to go the church in my uniform. That’s just how I was raised. Thank you mom for starting me off on the way I should go. Now that I am older, even though you are gone, I will not turn from it.
