One Moment in Time

It was exactly one year ago that one moment altered my life. I was in York, Nebraska at Soul Quest. We were doing a service project cleaning out the city's bus barn. There was a bank of lockers that they wanted removed. I took a dolly and tried to move it so the teens could sweep and clean up around it. The lockers fell and landed on my leg. I spent the rest of the day at the hospital and the rest of the week in a boot. I suffered a lot of soft tissue damage but fortunately no broken bones. But I could still relate to these words penned by David.

Have mercy on me, LORD, for I am faint; heal me, LORD, for my bones are in agony. Psalm 6:2

I spent the next several weeks walking on crutches. I spent the next couple of months preaching while sitting on a stool. I spent the next 5 months going to the wound care doctor every week. And to this day I have to spend some time every morning taking care of my leg. That seems like a pretty steep price to pay for one moment in time.

I'm still trying to reflect and understand just what lesson I was supposed to learn from all of this. Here are two that I was thinking about this morning: the devastation of sin and the love of God. Just one lapse in judgement or just one bad decision can affect the rest of your life. Just one sin can hobble you. However, we have a God that loves us. And our God is greater than our sin.


He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds. Psalm 147:3

We have all made mistakes in the past. But God offers us forgiveness and healing. It may take a while, and we may have to live with some consequences. But God will be with you every step of the way. I'm looking forward to the day when I can walk down the streets of gold with no scars on my leg.
