What's in a Name?

This week at our JOY group luncheon I took a moment to brag on my Oklahoma City Thunder basketball team making it to the finals. The Thunder used to be the Seattle Super Sonics. They changed their name to Thunder when they moved as an obvious reference to the weather. It is interesting how teams choose their names. The Thunder are playing the Indiana Pacers who got their name from the pace car used in the Indianapolis 500. A few NBA team names are pretty obvious like the Miami Heat, Phoenix Suns, Denver Nuggets (because of the gold rush), Detroit Pistons (the Motor City and parts of an engine), Orlando Magic (Walt Disney's Magic Kingdom), Houston Rockets (the home of NASA) and the Philadelphia 76ers (the Declaration of Independence was signed in Philadelphia in 1776). Some are a little more obscure like the Los Angeles Lakers. There are no lakes in the area. But the team was originally in Minnesota, the land of 10,000 lakes.
