# What's in a Name?

This week at our JOY group luncheon I took a moment to brag on my Oklahoma City Thunder basketball team making it to the finals. The Thunder used to be the Seattle Super Sonics. They changed their name to Thunder when they moved as an obvious reference to the weather. It is interesting how teams choose their names. The Thunder are playing the Indiana Pacers who got their name from the pace car used in the Indianapolis 500. 
#### The disciples were called Christians first at Antioch. Acts 11:26b
