# **Summit Day**

I have a love/hate relationship with an event that is called Wilderness Trek which I have done 6 times. At Wilderness Trek, you leave everything behind except a couple sets of clothes, a few cooking supplies, a tent, a sleeping bag, and whatever food you can carry. We would spend 5 days hiking through the Colorado mountains, and on the last day we tried to summit one of the 14,000 foot peaks. My first year on Trek we started hiking at 5 AM on summit day. About 5:15 one of my youth group girls named Carrie started crying. Through her tears she said that she was never going to make it and wanted to go back to her tent and lay down. I spent the next 6 hours walking with Carrie and constantly encouraging her to keep going. A little after 11 AM we summited the mountain. She was elated, I was exhausted.

The next summer I took for granted how good of shape I was in. As we started out early in the morning on summit day I thought to myself, "I am never going to make it to the top." During the next 6 hours different youth group kids would walk with and give me encouragement to keep going. As we made it to the summit and began hugging and taking pictures I realized that I never would have made it there without the encouragement of others.


Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing. 1 Thessalonians 5:11

We will have that feeling that we will never make through this difficulty or this season of life and we just want to quit.
