How to Train Yourself

Last week I took 7 campers and 2 staff members to Camp Horizon. On Saturday night the 2 staff members had meetings. So, I decided to take the rest to see a movie. They chose to see the movie "How to Train Your Dragon". This is a movie that I never would have seen on my own. But the truth is I enjoyed the movie. Here is a quick plot summary. In the mythical Viking village of Berk, dragons often attacked, stealing livestock and endangering villagers. A 16 year old mess up, aptly named Hiccup, is told to stay inside during an attack. Wanting to prove himself, he sneaks out and actually shoots down a rare dragon. He searches for the dragon, determined to kill it. However, when he finds it wounded he decides not to kill it and instead befriends it. **>Spoiler alert<** In the end this decision saves the future of the entire village. When Hiccup was asked why he didn't kill the dragon he responded, "I wouldn't kill him, because he looked as frightened as I was. I looked at him and I saw myself."

When I heard that line I pulled my phone out and wrote it down. Over the next 5 days at camp I was going to be teaching a class on "Compassion". The goal for my class was to teach the campers that God has shown compassion to them by sending Jesus to die for our sins even though we are worthy of death. And because God has shown such great compassion for us, we should show compassion for others.

Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

We are all in the same boat. All of us are sinners. We all stand in need of compassion from God. So when we look at others we should not only see someone who was made in the image of God, we should see ourselves. Someone who needs compassion.
