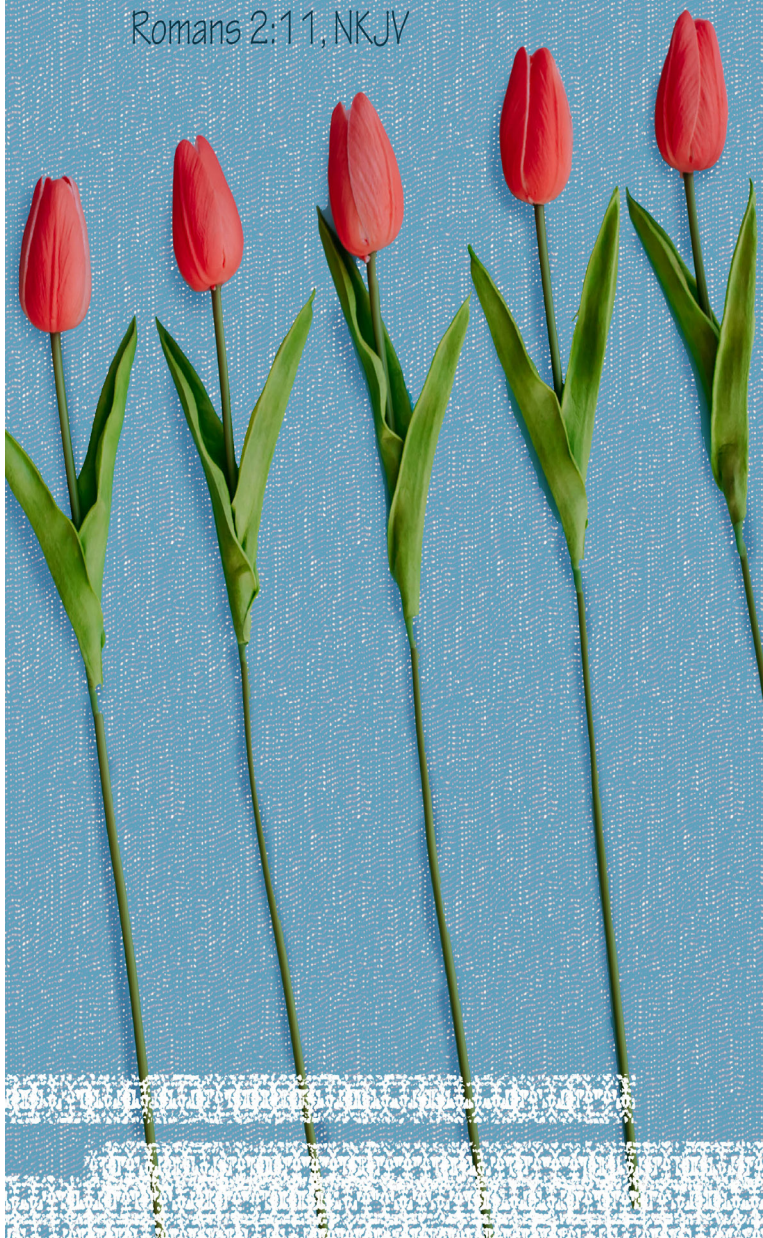

Let it Shine

Mark chapter 5 tells the story of a man who could make the horror movies of today look like Disney cartoons. The man called himself Legion because he was possessed by many demons. The local townspeople, not only banned him to the cemetery, they bound him with chains and iron in order to keep him there. But Legion was able to break free. He spent his days and nights roaming among the tombs and the hillside crying out and cutting himself with stones. Until one day when he came face to face with the Son of God. Jesus cast out the demons and restored him to his right mind. This may be the greatest transformation of an individual in the history of the world. When it came time for Jesus to leave the man begged to go with Him. But Jesus had other plans for him.

Jesus did not let him, but said, "Go home to your own people and tell them how much the Lord has done for you, and how he has had mercy on you." Mark 5:19
