Finding Joy in God's Word

I love listening to 80's music. I graduated high school in 1985 so 80's music is truly the soundtrack of my youth. A few weeks ago on a long drive I told my phone to play the hits of the 80's. I spent the next couple of hours singing along with every song. It was amazing how the lyrics to each song just seemed to flow out of my mouth. Some of the songs I had not heard in 40 years, but the lyrics were still there somewhere in my brain. It made me stop and think, "I wish scripture would just flow out of my mouth the same way these songs were." I pondered the question for a while and found this answer. I have always listened to music just for the joy of it. But reading scripture was usually for study or to get through my daily bible reading. I read God's Word with a purpose. But joy has not been the purpose.

Let me tell you the story of a man named Scott. Scott Stapp is the lead singer, founder and lyricist for the band Creed. Scott was raised in a very strict Christian home. When Scott would get in trouble his punishment was to copy the Psalms in his own handwriting. In an interview he said that he must have written the 150 Psalms more than a hundred times. Needless to say as an adult he has a real love/hate relationship with God and His Word.

As your words came to me I drank them in, and they filled my heart with joy and happiness because I belong to you, O LORD God of Heaven's Armies. Jeremiah 15:16

Scripture should be a joy and not a chore. So I guess what I'm saying is that "I Know this much is True". If you are ever feeling "All out of Love" and you "Want to Know what Love is". "Don't Stop Believing" in the power of God's Word. Approach it with "Open Arms". Drink it in with "Every Breath you Take".
