Don't Drink the Poison

We have seven recorded statements that Jesus said while He was hanging on the cross. While all had deep spiritual meaning, one of the things Jesus said not only blesses us today, it challenges us. After multiple illegal trials where powerful people lied to convict Jesus, He was beaten, taunted, spit on, had a crown of thorns embedded into his head and made to carry His own cross. While on the cross the Roman soldiers were gambling for His clothing, the criminals on either side of Him were reviling Him, the religious leaders were mocking Him and the crowd was blaspheming Him. Jesus spoke and said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing" (Luke 23:34).

There's an old quote you may have heard that says, "Unforgiveness is like drinking poison and hoping the other person dies." Did the people deserve forgiveness for their words or actions? No! Did the people even ask for forgiveness? No! But Jesus understood that holding on to bitterness was a poison that He was not willing to drink.

"Do not judge, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven. Luke 6:37"

Our hearts only have a limited amount of space. When we allow anger, bitterness and revenge to occupy space in our heart it is a poison that will sicken our entire life. Forgiveness is the antidote that will free up space in our heart for love, grace and mercy. So follow the example of Jesus. Don't drink the poison.
