Value Faith over Perfection

Several years ago while on vacation Krista and I went to see “Hamilton” on Broadway. To say that this is an award winning musical would be a huge understatement. At the 70th Tony Awards Hamilton received a record breaking 16 nominations and won 11 awards including Best Musical. It also received a Pulitzer Prize for Drama. During the performance Krista was on the edge of her seat. I’m a little embarrassed to say that I was not nearly as overwhelmed as she was. I would prefer seeing children doing the Nativity scene at Christmas time. Don’t get me wrong, Hamilton was amazing. Every singer was a professional hitting every note and step to perfection. While at the typical kids Nativity play there will be forgotten lines, mistimed entrances, shepherds fighting, Mary waving at her parents and Joseph’s beard falls off. And those are the plays that don’t include live animals!

Which of these looks more like real life to you? We would love for our lives to be as perfect as a Broadway performance. But most of our lives look more like the children muddling our way through while trying to tell the greatest story ever told.

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast. Ephesians 2:8-9
