Don't be Defined by Yesterday

"That's not who I am, it is just something I did". That sounds like either a lame excuse or a justification for some bad behavior. But let's look at it from another perspective. While at camp with the teens last summer, we went to see a movie on Saturday night. As we were leaving the theater into a dark parking lot I was searching for our van. I was not looking down and I stepped off of a curb. The next thing I know I am bumbling and stumbling on the pavement. I don't know what hurt worse, my pride or my knees, wrist and shoulder. Even though my pride took a big hit, I got right back up and continued walking. A few times during the week the teens reminded me of my fall but they didn't have to, the bruised knees and sore wrist was all the reminder I needed. So here's the deal. Yes, I'm the guy who fell. But no, I'm not the guy who falls. I may fall again someday. But one fall in the past or a fall I may have in the future does not define me.

I wish we could all apply that lesson to our walk with God. We have all bumbled and stumbled over some sins in the past. But we do not have to let that define us. Others may even remind us of our past sins, but they don't have to. We have the pain and the scars to remind us. We could all learn a lesson from Paul.

Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.

At one time in Paul's life Christians were his sworn enemy. He was solely focused on having all believers in Christ arrested and killed. But Paul refused to let that define him. His new focus was to serve God and spread the word about Jesus. Paul understood that he is not defined by yesterday. He is defined by who he is today and what he is striving for tomorrow. So like Paul I'm still up and walking forward. I'm just extra aware of curbs that may trip me up.
