# **Gather Around the Table**

After my first month of being the minister here at the Eastern Hills Church of Christ I had one question in my mind, "How are these people not the fattest church on earth?" I asked that because in my first four weeks here, we had three potluck dinners. Through the years of being a minister I have learned a few things about potluck dinners. First, most men have no idea how much effort goes into the meal. They just show up, get in line and fill their belly. Second, most of the women who make the potluck happen, experience too much stress. They worry about the plates, silverware, napkins, tablecloths, set-up, clean-up and constantly wonder if there is going to be enough food. Third, the children seem to always take the best pieces of chicken. I don't know if that is true but that is the complaint I most hear. And lastly, almost everyone misses the point of the potluck dinner.

Acts 2 tells us about the birth of this new thing called "The Church". The first sentence in the bible after the church was formed says this...

They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. Acts 2:42

It is important as a church to devote ourselves to learning and prayer. But the other things are equally important for a healthy church, eating and fellowship. Remember when Jesus and the disciples were joined by five thousand plus people on a hillside. The disciples suggested that Jesus dismiss the people so they could each head their own way and get something to eat. Jesus said, "No. Break them up into small groups and I will give them something to eat." Was it all about the food? No! It was all about the fellowship.

I'm so glad that we still have potluck dinners together. But next time remember that the food is just an excuse for us to spend some time in fellowship. And by the way, I'm sorry about that fat comment earlier!
