Give Thanks

Would you take that moment to thank God for a car or any other earthly treasure? Would you even thank God for relief from some earthly type of suffering? Or would you instead thank God and praise Him for who He is? Psalm 100 is a short psalm but within the few verses it gives us a few reasons that we should be truly thankful to God. Verse 3 says that we should be thankful because our Lord is God, we should be thankful because He made each of us, and we should be thankful because we are His people. Verse 5 says that we should be thankful because of His goodness, we should be thankful because His love endures forever, and we should be thankful because He has and always will be faithful.

Thanksgiving is only one day a year. Our thankfulness to God needs to permeate our lives every day of the year. Take the time to give thanks to the one who is worthy.
