How To Study The Bible (IN CONTEXT)

We have said/heard that we must keep the words of the Bible in context. What does that mean in a practical sense? Consider this:

- 1. First, the word we are considering from the Bible.
- 2. Then, the sentence from where the word was found.
- 3. Next, the paragraph from which the word is found is considered. (We are obviously broadening our study.)
- 4. Next, we find the book where the word was found. Which of the 66 books of the Bible was the word found?
- 5. Next, we must consider the covenant that the word is under. This is extremely important to know. God has different covenants or institutions for a particular people. Errors are made when people bring previous covenants forward, when God had no intention of such.
- 6. Next, the Bible as a whole is considered. We have heard, scripture must interpret scripture. This is a basic rule to understand all scripture.
- 7. Finally, the context of the *culture* in that day needs considered.

Therefore, the word and sentence studied for meaning will enlarge to what is indeed a contextual study. The value of contextual study is that it makes the interpreter/student, determine the intent and purpose of the author.

An enormous amount of false interpretation has been taught because the frame of reference by the author was ignored. <u>The contextual study is a powerful way to avoid error.</u>

God holds us – each – accountable to proper interpretation. But we can properly handle the word of truth!
