How To Study The Bible

- 1 Corinthians 2 (Commonly Misunderstood. Illumination.)
- **Vs. 1**. Paul's defense of his apostleship. This is a theme in both Corinthian letters. See: 4:3, 9; 9:1-2; 14:37; 15:1, 9-11. 2 Corinthians 1:21; 2:17; 3:1,6; 4:1,7; 5:20; 10:1-2; 11:6, 23; 12:1, 9, 10, 12; 13:3.
- Vs. 2-5. Paul does not accept the philosophy of the world.
- **Vs. 6-9**. Paul says the wisdom he has does not come from man but God only. The mystery in vs. 7 is that Christ is the expected Messiah. Vs. 8, Paul says that the Jewish rulers never understood who Jesus is. As we keep scripture *in context*, Vs. 9 refers to the preceding verses. We cannot know or hear from another man this mystery in vs. 8. Only from God the apostles can know.
- Vs. 10. "us" means the apostles only. See John 16:5-16, for instance. To say this applies to all Christians would make us all apostles.
- **Vs. 11 13**. We cannot know what God knows, unless he tells us. God, then, tells the **apostles** what he wants us to know. They have received *the Spirit who is from God*. (vs. 12)
- Vs. 14 16. Important! This is **misused** by the televangelists a lot. Paul is defending his apostleship (and all apostles). They have the mind of Christ. (Vs. 16b) The non-apostles (natural man) have not been given the truths from God. They are not inspired.
- **NOTE**: Any time a person claims that God is speaking through them (illumined), then they would have to be an apostle as found in the New Testament. This is serious that we understand to avoid false doctrine.
