How To Study The Bible

A closer look at 1 Corinthians 13. Remember the context we have talked about. Paul stated in Chapter 12 the lists of and acknowledges the miraculous gifts SOME of the Corinthians had.

Then, with that in mind, Chapter 13 was written to address the *gifts*. Chapter 13 is often addressed as poetry. It is not. Our setting is found in Chapter 12, verses 29-31. (Reminder, the scriptures were not written in Chapters.)

Ch. 13:1.

This verse is hyperbole, it is humorous. The Bible has humor. "Tongues of angels" is hyperbole (exaggerated claims/not literal). Question: What do angels say or sound like? Who knows?

Therefore, modern tongue speakers do not use language. It is gibberish. To explain what they are doing, they say we are speaking in tongues of angels. In fact, one can Google charismatic's being trained in tongue speaking. This is all so sad. The devil is real!

13:2.

Again, this is hyperbole! To do what this verse says, one would have to know what God knows.

13:3.

Again, extremes mentioned to make a point. The Corinthians sacrificed the greater for the lessor. Love had died in Corinth. This church had many issues, but this may have been the worst. To lose the love God has shown us is tragic. They thought the miraculous was most important. Sad.


