DILIGENCE & DISCERNMENT

Those two words were used in a Trail Life lesson this past week to teach about Godly citizenship. (Imagine young boys being taught Godly citizenship! Super!) What do they mean to us?

<u>Diligence</u>: careful and persistent work effort/ doing one's part while keeping faith and reliance on God/ being honest, trustworthy, and reliable.

<u>Discernment</u>: ability to judge well/ ability to make a smart judgment about something/ judging between right and wrong, good and evil, truth and lie.

Both words sound like a good description of the Christian. Our **Christian worldview** must be one that sees God in all we do! In class we gave the example of what glasses you are wearing. Are you wearing *dark* glasses where you see through the lens of the world/worldly? Or are you wearing *light* glasses that see through the lens of Scripture?

Bring a Godly citizen is a person who evaluates and judges **everything** about their life through the lens of scripture!


