Strength In Numbers

We were learning how to tie different knots in **Trail Life**. It is amazing how many knots and cords there are. They are for a variety of uses. The cords reminded me of the verse from Ecclesiastes: And though a man might prevail against one who is alone, two will withstand him---a three-fold cord is not quickly broken. (v. 4:12).

Some cords/knots are stronger than others of course. Some require, by their use, that they do not fail. They are required as a knot to hold tight to the object to which it's fastened. Common sense is it not? Are **we** not to hold tight to the Lord?

Yes, as a Christian we are to hold, to be fastened to Christ Jesus our Lord. We do not want to fail in that! We want a strong cord/rope to be fastened to the Lord God. That means a three-cord for strength. The Apostle Paul says at least twice what a three-cord would be like for the Christian.

1 Cor. 13:13, *So now faith, hope, and love abide, these three: but the greatest of these is love.*

1 Thess. 5:8, But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, having put on the breastplate of faith and love, and for a helmet the hope of salvation.

Paul teaches that **faith**, **hope**, and **love** will sustain the Christian! When we go through dark days or bright days these three will keep us joined to the Lord! Living by these will be our "three-cord" so we will not fail! Amen!

They will keep us joined to the Lord. They will keep us joined to our fellow Christians. They will keep us joined in compassion for the lost. They are a must! Thank you, Lord God!


