But I didn't know! Pt. 1

Many will face God someday and say those words. They will try to plead ignorant of who He is and that they are accountable to Him.

Paul speaks of God's wrath to come to **all** men due to their unrighteousness. (**Read: Romans 1:18-20**) Many will say, "BUT I DIDN'T KNOW THERE WAS GOD. And if I didn't know there was God, then why does he bring wrath upon me?", they will say?

Paul is clear that all men are without excuse! No one will be able to plead ignorance on judgment day. We all have available evidence to know of God's existence, says Paul. Just what is it that is available to all human beings?

Paul says, in things that have been made. So they are without excuse. (v. 20) Mankind can look around the world they live in and see creation, what has been created by God. No one can say on judgment day that they did not realize God existed.

The problem is, the eternal problem, is that at judgment day, it will be too late to say, *Oh*, *I believe in God*. God's wrath will be given out. (v. 18) Salvation that God offers through Christ will have been missed. Most will be doomed. (See Matt. 7:13-14) That is the most tragic realization of all. It deeply saddens the heart.

But why do people **not** see God exists through creation? What God considers obvious, that someone created all this, most of mankind does not see. Why?


