Please arrive at camp on Monday September 22nd between 9am and 9.30am.

Camp is located at LifeSwitch on the grounds of Silverstream Retreat, 3 Reynolds Bach Drive, Lower Hutt.

- ☐ A drink bottle for water – please name this clearly.
- ☐ Medications - clearly marked with the camper's name & medication requirements (amount, frequency, purpose). These will need to be handed in on arrival and administered by our staff.

Please **do not** bring cellphones or any other electronic devices. We cannot be responsible for any loss, theft, or damage of these types of devices and cannot provide a secure lock-up facility for them. Also please do not bring weapons of any kind including pocket knives etc.

▪ **Collecting your child from Camp:**

Camp finishes with a brief prize-giving starting at 10.30am on Wednesday 24th September. Parents and families/friends are invited to attend.

We are only able to release your child to one of the people you have nominated on your registration form so please ensure that you/they are at Silverstream Retreat before 10:30am to watch the prize giving and collect/sign-out your child. If you need to nominate someone else to collect your child – please email laurel@lifeswitch.org.nz or text 027 249 2805.

- **If your child is sick**, please keep them home from camp until they are better so that their sickness will not be spread to others. You are welcome to bring them when they are better. Please contact Laurel - laurel@lifeswitch.org.nz or text 027 249 2805 if your child will not be attending on the first day.
- **Rules are kept to a minimum** and campers are expected to co-operate with these. Most relate to standards of behaviour and respect for other people and property. For the sake of harmony and safety in camp, discipline is firm but kind. Camp Survivor reserves the right to send home any child who refuses to co-operate.
