### **I Corinthians: Godly Solutions for Church Problems**

Sundays at 9:05 or 10:15 am in the NB Multi-Use Rm. Let's be honest: The things we say and the way we act often aren't consistent with what we say we believe in church on Sunday. The members of the first-century church in Corinth struggled with this very same problem. Even though the Apostle Paul himself had established that community of Christians and continued to stay in touch with them, their failure to live lives consistently guided by the teachings of Jesus were frequent, embarrassing, and sometimes painfully public. So, Paul wrote to them to help them (and us) become a better community of disciples.

In his *First Letter to the Corinthians*, we find that Paul's primary focus is helping the Corinthians to bring their behavior more "in tune" with the faith they professed. He accomplishes this "tuning" by reviewing key Christian beliefs that help shape righteous living, and points out that moral failures frequently flow from flawed beliefs.

Before the big day, here's what our confirmands need to remember: Confirmation Books are Due: Sunday, October 5 at or before the 10:30 am service.


Heads up—Ignite won't meet that week due to Fall Break. Make sure all requirements are completed.



### ~Introducing Pastor Ken Hennings~



Pastor Ken Hennings has joined the team at Risen Savior as a part-time Assistant Pastor for Congregational Care. He will be teaming up with our current part-time Assistant for Congregational Care, Pastor Dave Poedel. Pastor Ken will be joining Pastor Dave in calling on the homebound and hospitalized as well as serving as the Liturgist twice a month in the Traditional services. Pastor Ken will also serve as the primary teacher at the Sunday morning Adult Forum Bible Study. In addition, Pastor Ken will be responsible for our Traditional worship service, writing the liturgies, selecting the hymns, and working with our Organist and Choir Director.

A little bit of background on Pastor Ken is that the past twelve years of ministry he was serving as President of the Texas District, helping the district move toward a Mission Movement mentality where trained lay people became evangelists to their communities. This movement allowed the Texas District to increase the number of new congregations started each year. During the last three years as the District President, he served as Chairman of the Council of Presidents (COP) of the LCMS and Val (his wife) supported the District President wives with activities and fellowship during the COP meetings. This August Ken and his wife celebrated their 55th wedding anniversary. They have been blessed with four wonderful children and eight delightful grandchildren. Three of those grandchildren live in Mesa, and they look forward to attending their school and sporting events.

#### Transition Information from the Risen Savior Board of Directors/Transition Team

<u>Update 1</u>~In conversation with Pastor Ron and Susan Mello, Director of Operations, we learned that both will be looking to retire in the next 3 - 5 years. Given that these two positions play a key role in our ministry, the Governing Board has formed a Transition Team to carefully make plans for a smooth transition. In addition, the Board has hired a consultant who works with large churches where the senior leader is retiring. While 3 - 5 years seems like a long time away, time has a way of going by very quickly and we want to be very intentional in our planning.
