





GETTING TO KNOW US...

Risen Savior first opened its early childhood program in 2002 with three classrooms and 88 students. We have had three building campaigns over the years, adding the education wing, a modular building, and the second floor. We are currently operating with nine classrooms, serving Infants through Kindergartners in the South Building. The facility also features a MultiPurpose Room, Library, STEAM room and the Indoor Play Area for toddlers. Many of our young children enjoy their specials – music, library, yoga, science, and art in these classrooms.

Risen Savior's Early Childhood Center (ECC) is rated a 4-Star center by Quality First and participates in Arizona's quality initiatives like the Apprenticeship Pathway and the Pyramid Model. Bible Study: 2 Corinthians

Begins January 11 at 9:05 or 10:15 am in the North Building Discipleship Room. Sometimes even your best effort doesn't seem to be enough. You've explained things as clearly as you could, given the best advice you know, offered all the help you could give... and then someone else comes along when you've had to step away, confuses everyone, and proceeds to mess things up.

In his Second Letter to the Corinthians (2 Corinthians), Paul found himself in the position of cleaning up and straightening out what has become an angry mess in the church at Corinth. False teachings and false teachers have thoroughly confused the Corinthian congregation, which was already struggling to be faithful in a pagan society that cared nothing for God's ways and plans. 2 Corinthians is an intensely personal letter from the apostle Paul, written to bring the church fully from the bewildering darkness swirling around them, back to the saving light of Christ and the embrace of God's grace.

In this new study, we will listen to the correcting advice Paul gave the Corinthian church in this powerful letter. Each session will cover a section of 2 Corinthians, providing background to more fully understand each problem being highlighted and the insight Paul's letter provides for avoiding that mistake. Our study guide (available for purchase at the first class for \$6) includes the full text of each session's portion of 1 Corinthians, helpful notes on important words and points of the passage, links to other scriptures that further reveal the message Paul is giving, and questions to guide and deepen our understanding of the text. Visitation Ministry






ADULT FORUM

Risen Savior Core-God Talk




