



#### Rummage Sale Thank You!


Huge thank you to each of you who volunteered your time and to those who donated items to this year's Rummage Sale.






#### Women's Morning Ministry No Meeting Nov. 27

#### Lutheran Women's Missionary League



### Bible Study: The Book of Isaiah



# Adult Forum No Meeting Nov. 2

Adult Forum has started a study of the Gospel of Mark. During the month of October, the class will look at Jesus' ministry in Galilee. How did the people respond to the miracles and teachings of Jesus? What expectations did the disciples have about what Jesus would say and do? Why were the religious leaders negative toward Jesus? Bible stories about Jesus at times seem to be just historical events of life many centuries ago. Do we experience fear or a feeling of awesomeness when we read Biblical events? Do we stop and ask ourselves what the historical Jesus means for our lives? Come and learn who Jesus is for you today through the eyes and experiences of the disciples and people in Mark's Gospel. All adults are invited to learn about this interesting Gospel.

#### Sunday Bible Study

I Corinthians: Godly Solutions for Church Problems Sundays at 9:05 or 10:15 am in the NB Multi-Use Rm. Let's be honest: The things we say and the way we act often aren't consistent with what we say we believe in church on Sunday. The members of the first-century church in Corinth struggled with this very same problem. Even though the Apostle Paul himself had established that community of Christians and continued to stay in touch with them, their failure to live lives consistently guided by the teachings of Jesus were frequent, embarrassing, and sometimes painfully public. So, Paul wrote to them to help them (and us) become a better community of disciples.

In his *First Letter to the Corinthians*, we find that Paul's primary focus is helping the Corinthians to bring their behavior more "in tune" with the faith they professed. He accomplishes this "tuning" by reviewing key Christian beliefs that help shape righteous living, and points out that moral failures frequently flow from flawed beliefs.



#### Who is Jesus?

This is the most important question we can ask:

Who is Jesus?

In a world in which information is readily available and opinions abound, this fundamental question stands above all other inquiries and considerations.

The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod believes Jesus is exactly who He said He is. Along with the ancient Church, we confess that Jesus is true God and true man in one person. He is the Son of God who was crucified and raised from the dead for the salvation of all who trust in Him.

Christ is not Jesus's last name, but identifies Him as the Messiah (Christ is the Greek translation of Messiah), the fulfillment of the Old Testament promises that God saves His people.

This fulfillment and salvation happened in history in real time and in a real place (first century AD in Israel) through a flesh-and-blood person named Jesus.

The Bible is the true and trustworthy Word of God that records God's love for the world through His Son Jesus. The miracles recorded in the Gospels and the teachings of Jesus are true and accurate.

Jesus physically died on a cross and physically rose from the dead in three days. He physically ascended into heaven, and the Church awaits His second coming when He will judge all people.

Those who trust in Jesus as their Savior will rise to eternal life in heaven. Those who deny Jesus and live in their sin will be cast out of His presence to hell.
