Dispute #1 (Malachi 1:2-5)

Focus: God's <u>love</u> for <u>His</u> people.

Despite their unrighteousness, God had <u>chosen</u> to be His people, and had <u>saved</u> them to share His goodness with <u>the nations</u>.

Focus: Israel's illegitimate worship.
