

Here are the highlights from the First UMC Council meeting held on Thursday, July 17

CELEBRATIONS: Community Kids Camp was a tremendous week with 97 kids registered and over 45 volunteers helping out. The cost for the meal FUMC provided (for kids and many parents) was approximately \$250. We appreciate the donor who gave \$150 toward this meal!

We are so grateful for this multi-church collaboration and for the FUMC volunteers who helped out! Most of all, we are thankful for the 97 kids who heard about Jesus' love for them and had a great time learning, playing, and experiencing acceptance in a Christian community. Next year the ALC will host and then the camp will be back at FUMC in 2027.

CHALLENGES: We are currently \$7571 behind on apportionments. This includes half of April, all of May, and all of June. The hope is to be able to pay all of July's apportionments (\$2857). This potential shortfall is mitigated, albeit partially, by the recent approval from the Foundation to provide additional funding for the Family Life position salary for the remainder of the year.

CURRENT FOCUS: Affirmation of the church's new mission and values statements: Mike Brignac, Rick Dalrymple, Ellen Hoefker, and Deb Steinle have worked with Pastor John to create new vision and value statements for the church. The Council members all voiced approval and appreciation for these statements, which will be presented to church members at the Sept. All-Church Gathering. We look forward to sharing this at our All Church Gathering in September.

Foundation: The number of scholarship applications is down a bit this year, but is currently being reviewed by the committee.

Approved additional financial support for the Family Life position for the next two years.

Provided funds for the replacement of the laptop/tech equipment

used in services, as the computer was very outdated and "freezing up" during services.

Worship Design Team: led by Pastor John. This team will meet several times a year with representatives of each component of church services. The pastor may provide a vision/wish and then ask the team to make that vision happen.

First, Adrian, and Christo en tu Ayuda churches will be partnering to serve at The Banquet in Sioux Falls on Aug. 18. Sign-up is under way and may be done via Realm (email from Pastor John), in the FUMC Narthex, or by contacting Pam Soderholm.

The Council discussed the need for locking church doors during services and possible individual concerns with this policy. This need is an unfortunate reality of the current world we live in and Pastor John will address this topic with the congregation. Unlocking the church early (approx. 9:00am) for coffee fellowship was previously Nancy or Jolene's responsibility, but others need to be identified.

Mobile Meal sign-up will be in August as we are responsible for delivering in September.

Family Life: The team is discussing what C3 can/should look like this fall. Their vision is to provide a regular mid-week event that inspires spiritual growth, fellowship, and belonging. The Book Club will meet later in July. Ladies by the Lake met in July and will meet again in August

CUTTING EDGE ISSUES: The Twins game was a fun, memorable event, but only 20 tickets were sold this year. The cost of the charter bus (paid for by the Foundation) went up to \$1500. The continuation of this event was discussed, and the idea of partnering with another church was suggested. This option would allow us to share the expenses and have a fuller bus.

Fall All-Church Gathering will be held on Sep. 14.

- Nominating Process: As the chair of a committee, he/she can nominate individuals and invite them to join a meeting after discussing with Pastor John. The Council can approve Pastor John's nominations.
- Hollie Hibma was unanimously selected to join the Missions Team.

Adult/Teen Challenge: Do we invite them each year or every other year? Should we look at bringing in a different group each year? There is no cost to us to host Adult/Teen Challenge except providing a meal. The Council decided that a group would be invited in 2026 due to the number of events/commitments already scheduled in the next few months.

FINANCIAL REPORT: Giving was up slightly from the previous month; however, expenses were also up with a couple of unexpected expenditures of a new floor cleaner battery and a \$5000+ water pump.
