#### WHY DO WE DO WHAT WE DO?

Each week we will be highlighting and explaining the why of what we do in the Divine Service each week. We will begin with the origins of the Divine Service:

When all have received the Body and Blood of Christ who will be communing during a given service, we join together in singing the Post-Communion Canticle. This is a response of thanksgiving for the great gift received. Sometimes we will utilize Simeon's Song of praise when he has seen Jesus in the temple called the Nunc Dimittis (now you let depart). The other hymn we will use is "Thank the Lord" where we sing the praises of Him who is both host and gift. Both musical settings express our sheer joy in what we have received. We then pray together the Post-Communion Collect, again we express our thanksgiving for what we have received and what we have yet to look forward to in Christ. (24)
