

Kidstowne

KidsTowne, our ministry for infants through 5th graders, has grown tremendously this year. Averaging 160 kids each Sunday—a 56% increase—it's become a place where young hearts discover God's love in fun, meaningful ways. This summer, 52 kids attended our Science and Art Camp, exploring creativity and faith together. Through caring leaders and engaging lessons, KidsTowne is building a strong foundation for the next generation to know and follow Jesus.









Youth

2025 has been an exciting year for Crosstowne Youth! We launched our new Wednesday night youth gatherings in August, creating a consistent space for students to grow in faith and community. Since then, we've averaged about 40 students each week across all youth services. This summer was packed with meaningful experiences — 31 students and leaders attended Student Life Missions Camp, and 21 middle schoolers joined our summer retreat. It's been a year of growth, connection, and seeing God move in incredible ways!

Men


Our Men's Ministry has grown significantly this year, reflecting a deep desire for spiritual growth and community. **Attendance at our retreat rose 15%**, with **56 men gathering** for worship and renewal, and 43 taking steps of deeper faith. Through discipleship and fellowship, men are pursuing Christ wholeheartedly and impacting their families, church, and community with purpose.

This year, our Women's Ministry has discipled over 200 women through conferences, mentorship, and gatherings—equipping them to grow in faith, build meaningful relationships, and step confidently into their God-given callings. 
Groups

Getting connected in community has always been at the heart of Crosstowne. This year, we've seen incredible growth in our Small Groups ministry— evidence of God drawing people closer to one another and to Him. This semester, over 200 people are actively participating in Small Groups, compared to 110 last semester—a remarkable 82% increase in engagement! Each week, men and women are gathering in living rooms, coffee shops, and across our campus to study Scripture, pray together, and build meaningful relationships. We celebrate the way God is using these groups to deepen faith and strengthen friendships. And with Bryan Brigman's new role as Community Pastor, there will be an even greater focus on helping every person find their place to belong and grow in genuine community.

In addition, Bryan Brigman transitioned from serving as our Youth Pastor to his new role as Community Pastor, where he is leading the charge in growing and developing our Groups Ministry—helping more people find meaningful connection and community at Crosstowne. As well as increasing the continuity of our campus through digital and physical mediums as we expand all of our areas of ministry.

In 2025, our church experienced such incredible growth that it became clear God was calling us to expand our team to meet the needs of our thriving community. This exciting season led to the creation of several new part-time staff positions, and we were blessed to welcome Tina Ward, Jake Sieg, and Shanna Nimmons into these roles. Each of them has brought unique gifts, passion, and dedication that have strengthened our ministry and helped us serve our congregation more effectively. Their addition not only reflects the growth we've seen numerically but also the deepening of our mission as we continue to build a church where people can grow in faith, connection, and purpose.


Stewarding Growth




54% Growth Among Us

Overview of Campus Expansion

God answered prayers that have been over **12 years in the making!** For more than a decade, we believed that He would one day provide the opportunity to expand our campus—we just didn't know when. In **October 2024**, that prayer was fulfilled as Crosstowne was able to **purchase Building 2**, adding **16,000 square feet** to our campus!

This expansion has created incredible new opportunities for ministry—especially for our **Next Gen environments** and **small group gatherings**. The remodel included transforming a former attic into a dynamic **Youth Room** built for both community and teaching, enhancing our **Kidstowne** spaces, adding multiple **new small group rooms**, and installing **five new air conditioners** to serve our growing congregation.

This exciting step forward was made possible through a combination of **your generosity in 2024** and our faithful stewardship of funds set aside each year in anticipation of God opening the door for this purchase—as well as preparing for potential **flood mitigation efforts**.
