- Bonnie explains that our sin will only hurt us if we don't confess it and turn from it. (James 1:14-15),
- When we feel nervous or worried, Bonnie reminds the kids of what the Bible says "Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4:6-7)



Solve the Mystery...

Today's adventure was full of lessons that teach us how to come closer to Jesus and live by His Word. Here are 3 discussion topics that will help connect the story to your daily life:

- 1. Peter felt God wanted him to pray for Hunter. Can you think of how God might want you to share the love of Jesus with someone, even when it might feel a little embarrassing?
- 2. Hunter hurt himself by trying to get revenge for something he thought was unjust. When did something happen to you that felt unfair and what does the Bible say we should do in this situation?
- 3. Peter told Hunter that he's not the only one -- we all make mistakes and do bad things. But when this happens what are we supposed to do? What does it mean to "come clean?"



Grow Your Faith... This episode has the themes of handling our hurt, sharing the love of Jesus, and repentance. Let's say a prayer, asking that God would guide us through our daily lives as we strive to take these themes to heart:

Dear God, I know you take care of us and you are in control of everything. So when I feel someone has wronged me or I am nervous about doing what you ask me to do, help me to trust you. And when I do mess up, I want to make it right right away, so sin won't hurt me or those around me. Thank you for your forgiveness and the peace that you give us!
