Follow the Clues...

Alongside every exciting mystery, the Clu Crew grow in their faith by discovering the truths inside Scripture. Did you spot the Bible verses they used to solve personal puzzles?

- When Bobby is worried about his ability to remember everything he witnessed, Peter tells him to cast all his anxiety on God “because he cares for you.” (1 Peter 5:7)
- When the Clu Crew hits an obstacle in their case, Claire reminds the Crew that their hard work will be rewarded. (2 Chronicles 15:7)
- At the end of the case, the Clu Crew realizes that Eric turned to robbery because of personal need. But Eric’s sister says that God always provides, even when money is tight. (Philippians 4:19)



Solve the Mystery...

Today’s adventure was full of lessons that teach us how to come closer to Jesus and live by His Word. Here are 3 discussion topics that will help connect the story to your daily life:

1. At the beginning of today’s case, Bobby gets very anxious and Peter comforts him with God’s word. Have you ever been anxious? What should you do when you are worried?
2. A theme of today’s episode is hard work. Have you ever worked hard on something and felt discouraged? What did you do? What kind of example did the Clu Crew set during frustration?
3. We learn that Eric, the bank robber, decided to steal because he was needing money. Have you ever stolen something because you thought you needed it? Why is it wrong to steal, and what should you do when you feel like you need something?
