- Bonnie and Clair explain that those who love God will value the animals he's given us (Proverbs 12:10) because God Himself enjoys what He has made (Genesis 1:21).



Solve the Mystery...

Today's adventure was full of lessons that teach us how to come closer to Jesus and live by His Word. Here are 3 discussion topics that will help connect the story to your daily life:

- 1. Bobby is frustrated that they have to "babysit someone else's kid." Have you ever been annoyed at having to help someone else? What can you learn from Bonnie's example?
- 2. Bella wanted the dog so badly she was willing to lie about taking him. Have you ever done something just because it's what you wanted? How can this be dangerous? How was Bella's situation dangerous because of her mom's choices?
- 3. Bella learned that loving something means doing what's best for it and not just what we want. Can you think of a way you can show love by doing something you don't really want to do?
