Slideshow Operator Volunteer

- Ensure right slide is showing on all screens at the right time

- Ability to trouble shoot any technical problems that arise
- Prior applied experience with PowerPoint is a bonus, but not necessary

- Technical expertise related to running sound

- Sunday mornings: Rehearsal + Service (2.5- 3 hours weekly)
- Potentially serve for special events as available
