- Willingness to learn and adapt to the specific needs of the ministry.
- It is a bonus if you've had experience working with children before BUT not necessary
- Must be member and have your clearances:
 - The church office will provide information on required clearances, and the associated fees will be covered by the church.

Commitment Expected

- For Monthly volunteers:
 - Participate in a once-a-month, 2-hour long evening.
 - Participate in any after-church meetings or special evening events (i.e. Missions Conference)
- For VBS volunteers:
 - You would attend Sunday-Thursday the week of VBS (again TBD) for about 3 hours in the evening along with a few meetings prior to the VBS kick off.

- Please clean up the kitchen afterward. If you anticipate not being able to, please notify the coordinator in advance.

- Please plan to be at church no later than 5:30pm until dinner is over (6:20ish). And, then plan for time to clean up the kitchen.

 - LPC Child Safety Policy: Read, sign and submit form stating that you have read and will comply with the LPC Policies and Procedures Concerning Child Safety
 - Mandated Reporter: Read document, sign and submit form stating that you have read document
 - o PA Criminal Background History report: Complete online or submit a paper application
 - PA State Child Abuse Clearance report: Complete online or submit a paper application
 - FBI Criminal Background History report: Sign and submit the Background Check Signature Form. If you have lived in PA less than ten years must be fingerprinted

Commitment Expected

- Attend Sunday-Thursday the week of VBS (July 28 August 1, 2024) for about 3 hours in the
 evening
- Attend a few meetings prior to the VBS kick off.
